# APPLICATION TIMELINE

## OCTOBER

- Begin researching university programs and application requirements

## JANUARY

- Number of seats (plazas) per program published
- Spring Semester starts
- Begin EBAU/PCE test preparation

## FEBRUARY

- First-week: UNEDasiss goes live credential evaluation
- Registration opens end Feb. for the PCEs\EBAU on UNEDasiss and closes early May

## APRIL

- Estimated deadline for private university example; Navarra
- HOUSING: Start process ASAP for private institutions
- Schedule an appointment with Spanish Embassy for Student-Visa application (Autorización de Estancia por Estudios) for private universities

## MAY

- Last week: Deadline to register to take the PCE/EBAU exams administered in Spain
- Last week: PCE/EBAU exams administered in Spain

\*NOTE - Students who have not yet graduated from HS should apply for a "permit for conditional admission / volante de inscripción condicional" via the Spanish Embassy in their country. This document shows that they started the accreditation process and allows them to be considered for admission.

## JUNE

- First 2 weeks: PCE/EBAU exams administered abroad
- Mid-June: Recommended latest deadline to submit UNEDasiss credential evaluation
- Spring Semester ends
- First week: Schedule an appointment with Spanish Embassy for Student-Visa (Autorización de Estancia por Estudios) application for public universities

## JULY

- Complete the preregistration process for public universities
- First week: International application deadline
- Last week: deadline to upload required documents

## AUGUST

- FINALIZE STUDENT-VISA

## SEPTEMBER

- Register for the Foreigner Identity Card (Tarjeta de Identidad de Extranjero or TIE) at the local Foreigners Office or police station once in Spain
- Fall Semester starts

## NOVEMBER

- Last week: UNEDasiss is live for credential evaluation

## DECEMBER

- Fall Semester ends
